

## POCKET LAP BLANKET

**GUIDELINES:** Please do not use religious themes, or embellish with sparkles, buttons paint, or anything that can fall off.

Make sure you are working in a clean, smoke free environment. Use only NEW Fabric. Use only gentle laundry detergent, no bleach, no fabric softener or dryer sheets.

**PLEASE:** Take extra care to remove all pins.

**OPTIONS:** Colorful Fun Theme Fabric for the Body with Plain Contrasting Fabric for the Pocket. Or - Plain Fabric for the Body with Fun themed Fabric for the Pocket.

## MATERIALS YOU WILL NEED

**FABRIC OPTIONS:** Anti Pill Fleece, or Soft, and Comfy Fleece, Ultra Cuddle Fleece, Minky or Faux Fur.

**OPTION:** Cotton Blend fabric for the reverse side, and the pocket.

## NON FUSIBLE STABILIZER

### CUT AND FINISHED BLANKET SIZES

CHILD SIZE: 30" LONG x 40" WIDE

TEEN SIZE 30" LONG x 50" WIDE

Serge, Zig Zag, Blanket Stitch or Decorative Stitch around all 4 sides.

**OPTION:** Turn the edges under 1/2 Inch and Top Stitch.

### FINISHED POCKET SIZE

TWO LAYERS OF FLEECE, WITH STABILIZER LINING.

10" LONG x 10" WIDE

**CUT POCKET FABRIC:** 10" WIDE X 20" LONG

**CUT STABILIZER:** 10" WIDE X 10" LONG

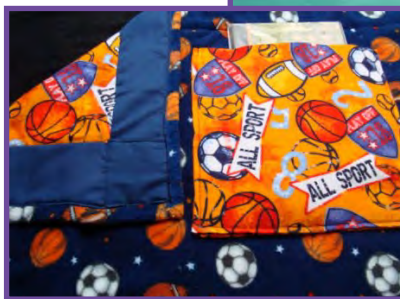
Fold the pocket fabric over, (The fold will be at the top) Place the stabilizer between the folded over fleece. 1 inch down from the top – Use Decorative, Blanket, or Zig Zag stitch across from one side to the other to give the pocket a nice finished look.

### ATTACH THE POCKET TO THE BLANKET:

Place the pocket 5 inches from the top. Center on the wide portion of the blanket Serge, Decorative, Blanket, or Zig Zag stitch the pockets three raw edges, down the left side, across the bottom, and up the right side, leaving the folded top of the pocket open.

Reinforce stitching at the corners of the top of the pocket.
